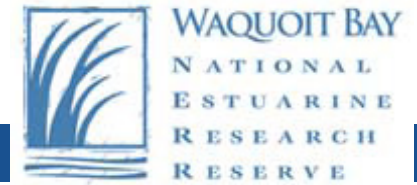


JULY & AUGUST SUMMER PROGRAMS - 2022
