- January 4, 2018 (Grayson)
 - MACC Opened, Some power outages.
 - Coastal Flooding, Rain Snow Mix
 - Provincetown
- March 3, 2018 (Riley)
 - MACC Opened, Major Power Outages
 - Coastal Flooding, Sand Bags
 - Sheltering, 93 MPH gust!



The Storms of 2018

- March 7, 2018 (Quinn)
 - Rain Event, for Cape Cod, Monitored Coastal Flooding
- March 13, 2018 (Skylar)
 - MACC Opened, Major Power Outages
 - Coastal Flooding, Sand Bags
 - Sheltering, Worst of the season.
- March 21, 2018 (Toby)
 - MACC Opened, Monitored for resource requests.
 - Quiet Event
