- Participate in a wrap-up meeting at the end of the season.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Experience working with children.
- Outdoor education and/or field experience.
- Current CPR/ First Aid certification required prior to start date.
- Must be knowledgeable about coastal ecology and comfortable working in the field and handling live marine invertebrates.
- Degree in a related field is a plus.
